- GALLO is a family-owned company, spanning four generations of the Gallo family who are actively working in the business.
- Established in 1933 and headquartered in Modesto, California, GALLO remains a privately held and ever-growing company that employs more than 7,000 people worldwide.
- GALLO offers a broad array of products that total more than 100 brands and include table, sparkling and luxury wines, ready-to-drink and malt beverage products, dessert wines, distilled spirits, and beer.
- With products available in more than IIO countries, GALLO is an exporter of California wine, and imports wines from Argentina, Chile, France, Germany, Italy, New Zealand, South Africa, and Spain. Additionally, Gallo imports spirits from Australia, the Caribbean, Italy, Mexico, and the United Kingdom.
- GALLO is one of the most highly acclaimed wine and spirits companies in the world, having earned major awards from prestigious competitions in the U.S. and internationally.
- Glassdoor selected GALLO as one of the top 100 Best Places to Work from 2017 through 2021, and again in 2024. Best Places to Work is an annual award from Glassdoor that weighs the scores of over 600,000 companies for their culture, values, career opportunities, CEO approval and overall employment rating.
- For the last nine years, GALLO has earned a 100% score on the Human Rights Campaign Foundation Corporate Equality Index, recognized as a Best Place to Work for LGBTQ Equality.
- GALLO's commitment to protecting the land and enhancing wildlife habitats through sustainable agricultural practices originated with the Winery's co-founders, Ernest and Julio Gallo, in the late 1930s. GALLO's North Coast vineyards have participated in a unique land management plan that was started by the co-founders, where for every acre of land planted in vineyard, one acre of property was set aside to help protect and enhance wildlife habitats.
- GALLO was recognized as the first winery in the U.S. to receive the International Standards Organization's ISO I400I certification, created to assist companies with reducing impacts on the environment.
- GALLO has led the way in developing and refining new environmentally friendly practices, such as minimizing the use of synthetic chemicals, fertilizers and pesticides, recycling and reusing process water, creating new wetlands and protecting existing riparian habitats.
